

#### DEAN'S MESSAGE

#### ABOUT KSOM



KIIT School of Management (KSOM), Bhubaneswar is one of the top B Schools of India with a ranking of 31 as per NIRF 2021, MHRD, Government of India. KSOM is a part of KIIT Deemed to be University, which has been ranked 601 – 800 in THE World University Rankings 2023 and ranked 151-200 in THE Young University Rankings. 




#### **Paper Presentations**
